

### **Budget Concerns:**

-Athletic Dept. budgets are small relative to the budget as a whole.

-Virtually every district spends substantially more on boys' sports than girls'.



- All districts have more Varsity spots available for boys than for girls, especially in the winter season.

- The \$20,000 needed to field a girls' team is an extremely small % of Athletic Dept. and District budgets.

- Possible to combine districts for preliminary program, thereby reducing cost.

- Strong parent booster groups will help.

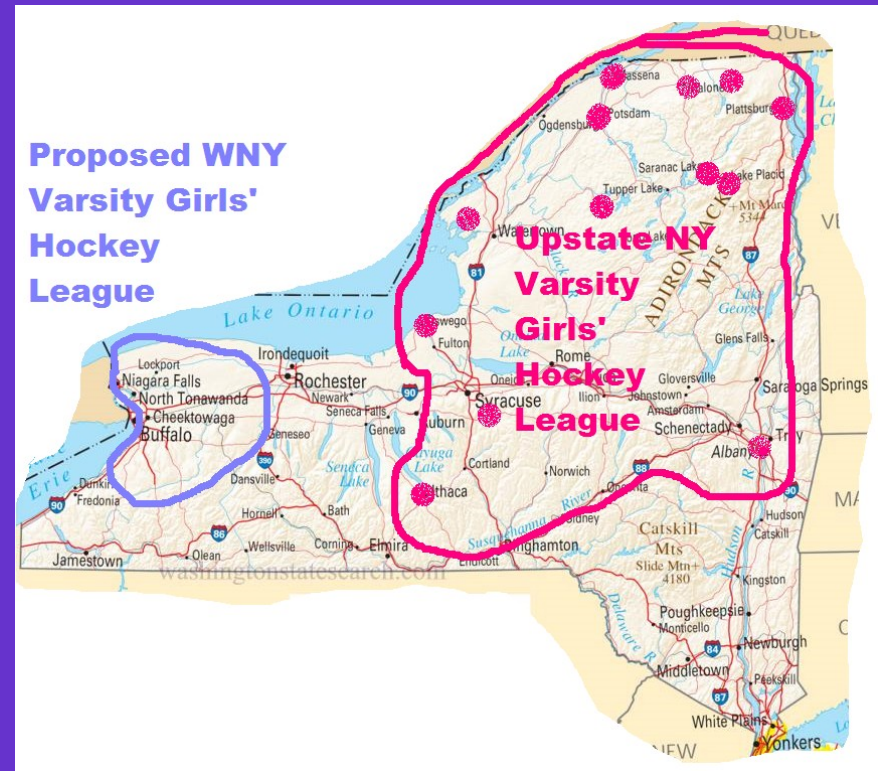
